The Science 8 and Mathematics 8 Jumpstart Camps are a week-long Science/Mathematics 7/8 transition program for incoming Grade 8 students who want to get an advanced look at the curriculum for Science 8 and Mathematics 8.

These preview programs are taught by veteran high school teachers (M.Ed. from U.B.C) with a combined teaching experience of 25 years.

Science 8 Jumpstart will consist of a review of key Science 7 concepts and provide students with a preview of the essential skills for their first year in Science 8 at S.T.A. Students will be taught the Scientific Method, basic skills will be reinforced, tons of activities, and new lab skills will also be covered during this week as labs are a large component of the Science 8 program.

Furthermore, students will be provided with a glance of different topics covered during the school year (Cells, The Kinetic Molecular Theory, Energy, and The Theory of Plate Tectonics).

Math 8 Jumpstart will preview key concepts covered in Math 8 and provide a future look on the different topics covered during the school year (Numbers, Computations, Linear Relationships, 3D Objects, and Analyzing Data). An overview of basic skills and proper techniques to solve problems will also be covered.

Furthermore, demos, activities, and practice reviews will be given daily to give students the edge of having an increased success rate for the upcoming Grade 8 school year!
